



Larimer County 4-H Shooting Sports Practice Policy-

Larimer County offers nine shooting sport disciplines: Archery, Air Rifle, Air Pistol, Shotgun, .22 Rifle, .22 Pistol, Muzzleloading, Western Heritage and Outdoor Skills. **Larimer County requires that all 4-H participants attend a minimum of four (4) county practices for each discipline in which they wish to participate in the county shooting competitions.** Failure to complete the required practices will result in not being allowed to compete at the county shooting event. Practices and participation at the county shooting events are not required to complete a shooting sports project. To complete a shooting sports project you must complete a record book and present a project during the county fair over a topic in your chosen discipline.

The county shooting competitions are held in late June and July, generally on a weekend. 4-H members must participate in a county shoot to qualify for the state competition. To participate in a state competition 4-H members must have a hunter education certificate. A bow hunter card is satisfactory for archery participants. Larimer County requires members to exhibit at the county fair and must receive a red ribbon or better in order to participate in the State Shooting Competition. Larimer County 4-H Shooting Sports has established the following required practices policy. All participants must attend a minimum of four (4) county practices for each discipline in which they wish to participate in the County Shoot. If the 4-H youth is participating in .22 rifle and air rifle, they must attend two practices for each discipline, rather than four practices in each discipline. Additionally, the information, orientation and/or safety meetings are required for all Shooting Sports participants to attend, but do not count towards required practices.

Two club practices, conducted by a state certified leader in the discipline will count if the following conditions are met: a list of planned Club practices must be sent to the Extension Office by April 1. A list of additional practices should be submitted one week prior to the time the practice is held. Other 4-H members who call may participate in the practice provided the range will accommodate increased numbers. The attendance list must be signed by the certified 4-H Shooting Sports Leader and sent to the 4-H Extension Agent within a week for the practice to count.
